



A step-by-step guide for installing [OsmAnd](https://osmand.net), downloading maps for the **East of England** and **Greater London**, and importing a **GPX** file. **OsmAnd** manages offline maps through **Maps & Resources**, and it supports importing **GPX** tracks/routes as part of its import tools. 1. Install OsmAnd

On Android

1. Open **Google Play Store**.
2. Search for **OsmAnd** or **OsmAnd+**.
3. Install the app.
4. Open it and allow location permission when prompted.

On iPhone / iPad

1. Open the **App Store**.
2. Search for **OsmAnd Maps Travel & Navigate**.
3. Install the app.
4. Open it and allow location permission when prompted.

2. Download maps for East of England and Greater London

1. Open **OsmAnd**.
2. Tap the **Menu** button.
3. Go to **Maps & Resources**.
4. Open the **Downloads** tab.
5. Search for **United Kingdom** or browse by country/region.
6. Download the map areas you need:
 - **England East**
 - **Greater London**
7. Choose the **Standard map** option unless you specifically need extras such as contour lines or terrain. **Standard maps** include roads, addresses, points of interest, public transport information, and other offline map data. [\[osmand.net\]](https://osmand.net)

8. Wait for the downloads to complete before travelling.

Tip: If you will be navigating without mobile signal, open **OsmAnd** before you leave and check that the map displays properly while your phone is offline.

3. Import a GPX file

OsmAnd supports **.gpx** files for tracks, routes, and waypoints. Imported GPX files are normally saved as tracks in the app. [osmand.net], [osmand.net]

Android method

1. Save the **GPX** file on your phone, found at www.essexclassicvehicles.co.uk/gps-trial, select either Fairlop or Bookers file.
2. Open **OsmAnd**.
3. Tap **Menu**.
4. Go to **Tracks**.
5. Tap the **three dots** menu.
6. Choose **Import**.
7. Select the **GPX** file.
8. Review the track preview.
9. Tap **Navigation** if you want to follow it straight away, then tap **Start**.

You can also open the GPX file from your phone's file manager and choose **Open with OsmAnd**, which is a common way to load it directly.

iPhone / iPad method

1. Save the **GPX** file in the **Files** app, iCloud Drive, email, or another app such as Dropbox.
2. Find the GPX file.
3. Tap **Share**.
4. Choose **OsmAnd**.
5. OsmAnd should open and show a track preview.
6. Tap **Navigation** if you want to follow it, then tap **Start**.

4. Find the GPX later

1. Open **OsmAnd**.

2. Tap **Menu**.
3. Go to **Tracks**.
4. Select the imported track.
5. Choose whether to show it on the map or start navigation.
